Position: Indiana FFA Development Internship (2)

Interns will be hired through the Indiana State Department of Agriculture

Primary Office Location shall be ISDA Offices - One N Capitol Ave, Indianapolis, IN 46204.

Description: Full time summer intern to work for the Indiana FFA. Responsibilities will include but are not

limited to the following: State Convention preparation, support and assistance in program

implementation, State Fair coordination, programs development/evaluation, conference curriculum research and development, mailings, data entry and administrative duties, and other jobs as needed.

Requirements: Education: Currently enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate with an accredited post-secondary

institution and have completed at least 1 year of undergraduate education.

Experience: Work with youth and adults, leadership training, agriculture education, partner

development, and the FFA organization.

Skills: Oral and written communications, program development, computer literacy, youth training,

team building, organizational and time management skills.

Salary & Time: ~\$600/week

Housing available at the FFA Leadership Center (optional)

Minimum 12 weeks

During high volume work weeks overtime will be required. (Example: State FFA Convention)

Benefits: Mileage and expenses reimbursement for official business, and some meals will be provided.
