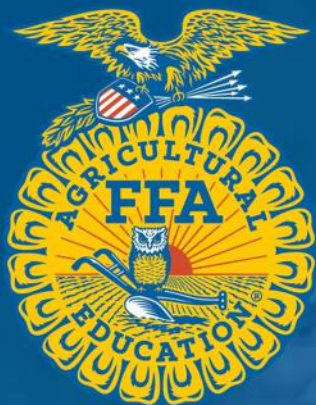

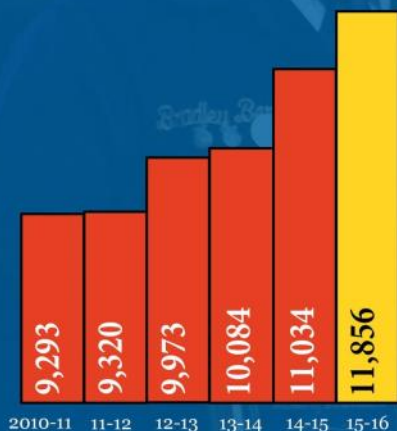

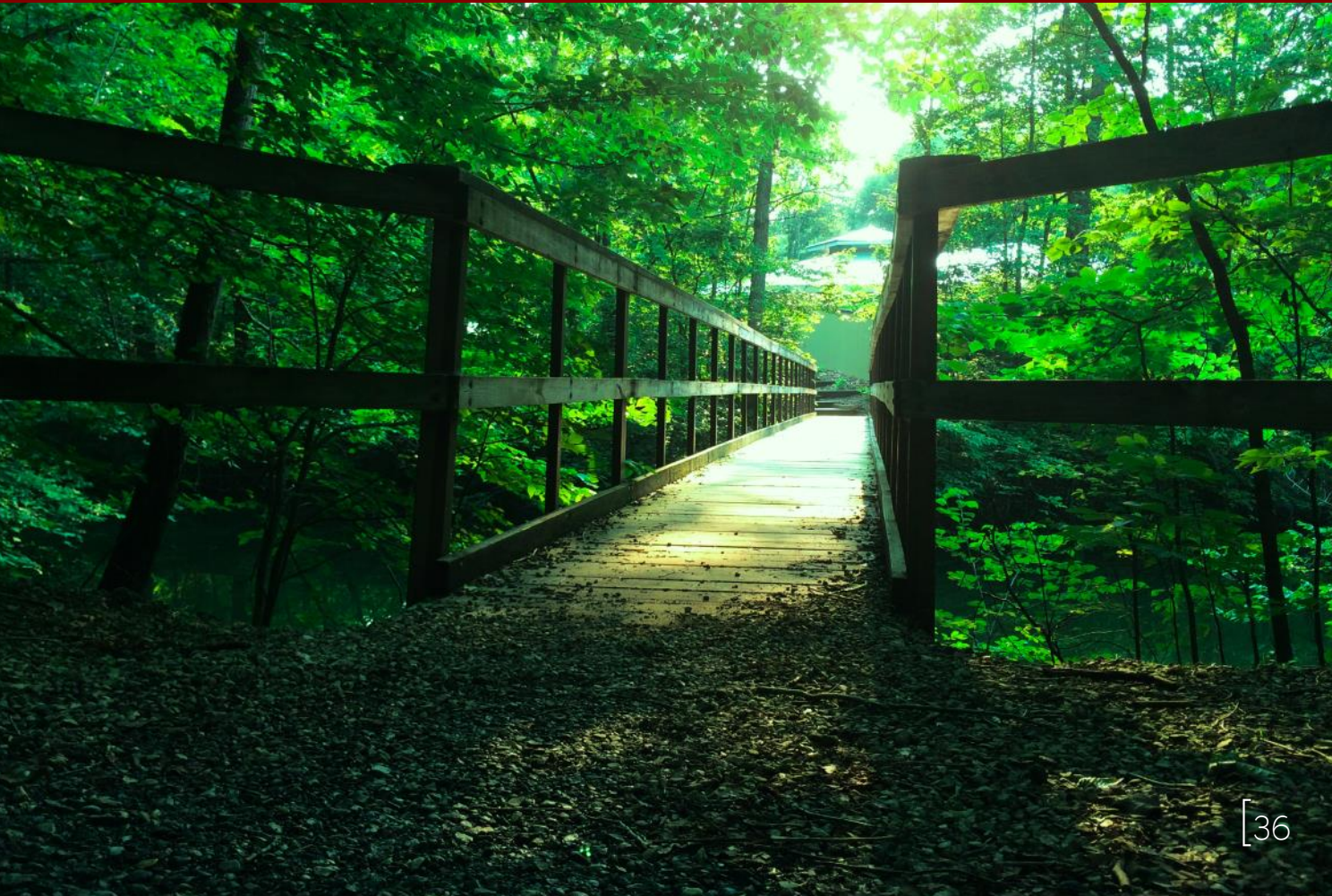

Read to Feed

This year, the Indiana FFA Executive Committee partnered with the Lt. Governor's office and Heifer International to launch the Indiana FFA Read to Feed Project. This project helped to combat hunger on a global scale and illiteracy on a local level. FFA Chapters partnered with local 3rd and 4th grade classrooms to track the amount of minutes that students were reading. FFA Chapters then partnered with local sponsors to raise money for Heifer International based on the amount of reading completed by the elementary school students.
