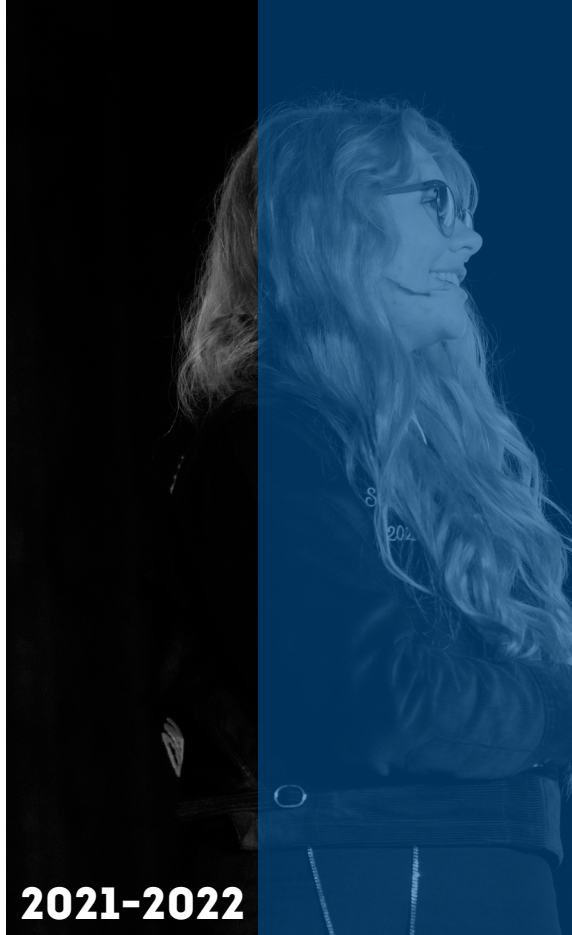

The Indiana FFA Foundation has been blessed with an outstanding fundraising year! On behalf of the board, I would like to thank all of our contributors and supporters who have made this year such a success.

We have seen positive growth within all categories of giving including individuals, local chapters, and corporate sponsors, all continuing to give of time and financial resources above what we could have imagined. The Indiana FFA Foundation 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Fundraising was

\$1,226,708, which is up \$176,632. With increased giving this year the foundation was able to continue providing the important resources that are necessary to develop agriculture leaders.

Another area of focus this past year has been our efforts around planned giving. The Huber Family Fund and the Rob Hays Memorial Fund were created to help support scholarship opportunities for Indiana FFA members. In the years to come, the foundation board will continue in these efforts.

For the first time since the COVID pandemic, Indiana FFA Leadership Center is back up and running at full capacity. The Indiana FFA Leadership Camps were back to historic levels, and it was so good to see all the students engaged. I am proud to say our leadership center staff has weathered the COVID storm extremely well and we are back investing in the leadership center for a bright future.

The annual Blue and Gold Gala raised \$64,127 in September of 2021. This event has continued to grow each year and we are excited to put this money toward the efforts of the Indiana FFA Association.

I would once again like to extend my thanks to all who have given this year and encourage your continued support for the most effective youth leadership development organization in Indiana!

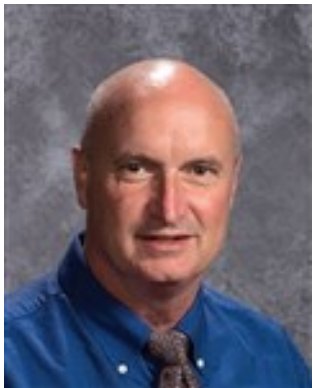

Grants Support Center Work



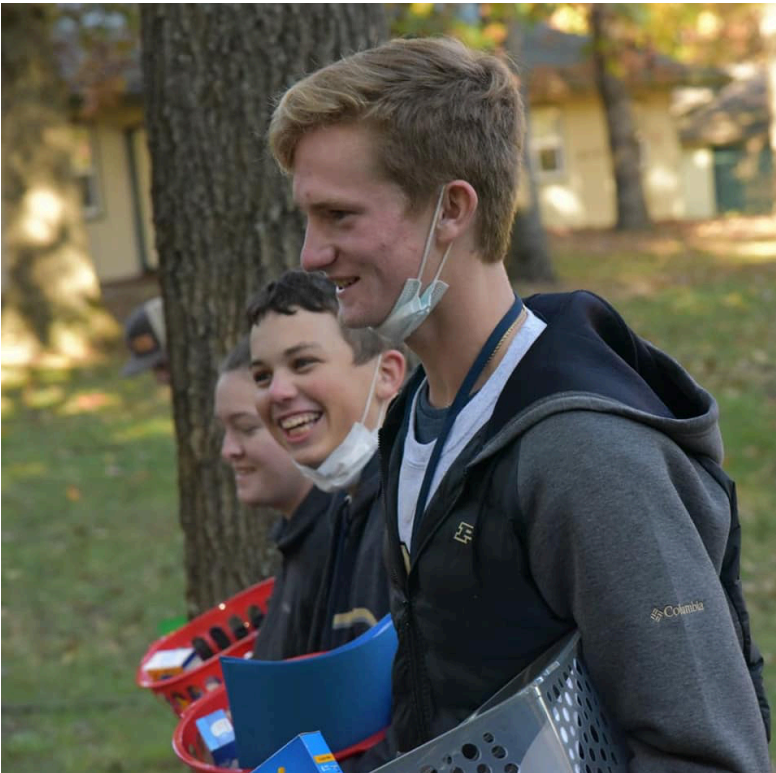

The grant to Indiana FFA Foundation is one of 297 that Lilly Endowment has made grants to through the Youth Program Resilience Fund to help youth-serving organizations across Indiana adapt their work to challenges caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Grants from this fund are part of more than \$170 million in grants Lilly Endowment has made to help organizations serve individuals and communities amid the pandemic.

Rural Energy Innovation Grant for energy efficient and updated lighting for the Indiana FFA Leadership Center in the amount of \$38,432. The Indiana Office of Energy Development (OED) offered a competitive funding opportunity to support rural area businesses for the purpose of energy innovation and improvement projects in rural Indiana. Funding for this grant comes from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and was administered by OED to enhance energy resilience and support state energy initiatives. Applicants identified infrastructure improvements that could reduce overall energy costs including decreased maintenance-related costs through the use of new or more efficient technologies. By diversifying energy sources, upgrading technology, and reducing energy consumption, grantees may also mitigate their exposure to price volatility.

Duke Energy Power for Students Grant provided professional basketball court backboards for the Leadership Center recreation area.

Johnson County Community Foundation granted \$6500 with the focus to offer at no cost to students in Johnson County, a one to three hours team building physical activities facilitated by trained professionals on the Leadership Center Challenge Course.

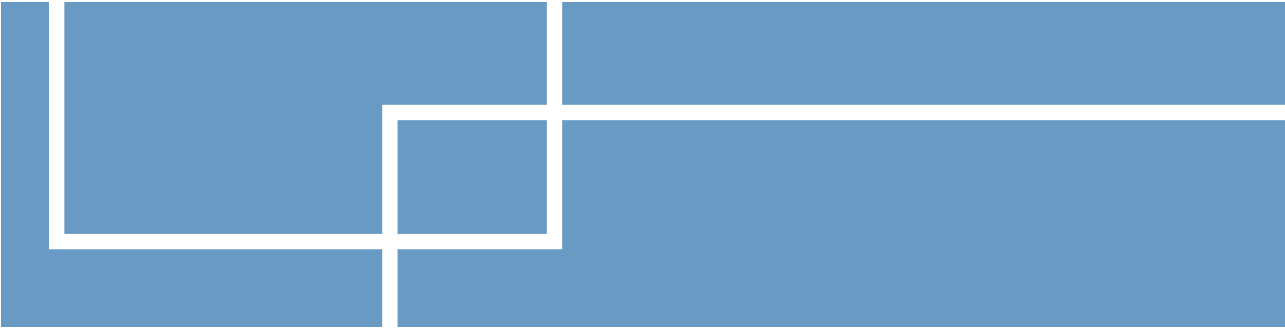

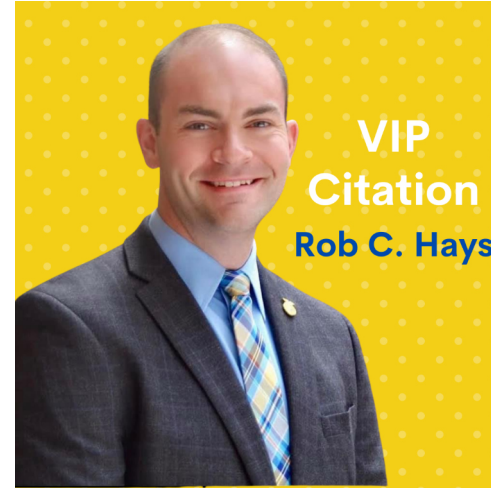
