The mission of the Indiana FFA Foundation is to support, fund, and promote the programs and objectives of the Indiana FFA Association.


Vision

Outstanding Service Award Recipients. Mr. and Mrs.
Lehman of Berne, IN have given over \$30,000 to the
Indiana FFA Foundation in just 16 years. Jeff and Sondra
both graduated from South Adams High School and
eventually took over as President of the family business,
Lehman Feed Mill. Running a 1.5 million bushel grain
elevator that purchases corn, soybeans, wheat, and oats



year-round is no easy task. But they have always made time for the things they cared about most, and one of those things was involving their sons in the local FFA chapter. All three of their boys, Adam, Nathan, and Patrick, had extensive success within FFA, each serving as Chapter Officers within the Adams Central FFA Chapter. As their sons were given higher leadership positions, they truly stepped up as parent supporters in any way possible. Jeff served on the Adams Central FFA Advisory board for many years, strengthening the Agriculture Education program and FFA Chapter by making recommendations for program improvement and providing assistance wherever needed. Both Jeff and Sondra have also served as judges for countless leadership contests for the district and state level. They have sponsored numerous events, scholarships, products, and awards for local FFA chapters and for the Indiana FFA Association. A Message from Seth Ariens

What does the word authentic mean to you? It reads: "of undisputed origin". From my team's perspective, we defined authentic as showing the members of Indiana FFA our true selves, showing them all our traits, good & bad; taking the time to connect with people on a personal level; and most importantly conveying the message that people are more powerful when they let their authentic self shine through. 



Often during the visits from state officers and staff, she would treat them with freshly baked cookies and treats. She and her late husband Roland lined their living room with plaques and honors from FFA. She supported her husband in his farming operation as well as worked for Jackson County Farm Bureau and Farmer's Production Credit of Seymour and served as the treasurer of Sauers Mutual Insurance Company, until retiring at the age of 90. Doris and Roland had it in their plans to give back to the Indiana FFA and they did just that. They not only gave their talents and time but of their wealth. Their legacy will live on in the many lives they impacted through Indiana FFA.



INDIANA FFA LEADERSHIP CENTER

Exciting things are happening at the Indiana FFA Leadership Center

The FFA Leadership Center has not gone without its share of grants and donations this past fiscal year and for that we are grateful. Since the purchase of the property in 1968, the Leadership Center is constantly looking to improve the facility and grounds. This cannot be done without the support of many of our FFA partners. In 2022-23 Indiana FFA was blessed with the following:

- A grant from National FFA provided by the Lilly Endowment made it possible for more than eight FFA
 Chapters to participate in overnight weekend events here at the Indiana FFA Leadership Center. Grants




Golden Owl Awards - Duane Huge, Winner
