After submitting an application, a personal interview, as well as a site visit, these members were deemed Star Finalists in their respective categories. Members determined as Star Finalists then are interviewed for a chance to be named as a State Star in these four prestigious award areas: Star Farmer, Star in Agricultural Placement, Star in Agribusiness and Star in Agriscience. They will find out the results on June 15th, 2022 at 7 pm at the Hoosier Degree Session during the 93rd Indiana State FFA Convention at Purdue University. Those determined as State Stars in each of the categories received a scholarship for \$250 sponsored by The Jeff Lehman Family. They will also receive a plaque and a copy of the Star videos showcasing each candidate's program, which are sponsored by Beck's Hybrids.
